Educator Role of Nurse in Health Services, Basic Concepts Related to Education and Training, Learning Areas, Learning Theories, Factors Affecting Learning, Theory of Multiple Intelligences in Teaching, Creating a Suitable Environment for Learning, Interactive Methods Used in Education, Tools and Materials Used in Education and Their Importance, Individual-Group and Society Education, Traditional and Contemporary Approach in Education (Pedagogy-Andragogy), Lifelong Learning, Adult Education, Characteristics-Basic Theories and Principles of Adult Education, Motivation in Adult Education, Using Communication Techniques in Education, Health Education, New Field of Health Education Theory and Practice, Ethics in Health Education and Characteristics of the Educator, Program Development for Health Education, Determination of Individual and Group Requirements, Determination of Educational Objectives, Content Determination and Regulation in Education, Program Implementation, Evaluation of Education, Health Education Example (Theoretical and Practice), Continuing Education (Adaptation to Work-In-Service Training), Effective Presentation Techniques.

Helitam 13 Fundamentals of Nursing: Theoretical total (28 weeks) - 336 hours

Health Care Systems, Ensuring and Maintaining a Safe Environment (Healthy and Safe Hospital Environment, Patient Admission and Discharge, Detectives, Preparation of the Patient Bed, Infection Chain, Hand Washing, Medical and Surgical Asepsis, Basic Principles of Medical Asepsis, Principles of Surgical Asepsis, Sterile Set Opening, Sterile Shirt Wearing, Sanitation, Disinfection and Sterilization Methods, Isolation in the Control of Infectious Diseases, Care of the Isolated Patient), Wound Care, Life Signs, Exercises Protective, Therapeutic

and Examination Positions, Ways of Drug Administration, Oral Drugs, Parenteral Drugs, Topical – Local Drugs, Maintenance of Fluid Electrolyte Balance, Intravenous Fluid Therapy, Total Parenteral Nutrition, Blood Transfusion, Respiratory Requirement, Nutritional Requirement, Emptying Requirement (Intestine), Excretory System (Uriner), Hot and Cold Applications, Sleep and Rest, Preoperative and Postoperative Care, Lost Death and Mourning.

Helitam 14 Basic Information Technology: Theoretical total (28 weeks) -112 hours

To provide students with information about basic concepts, computer hardware, software and internet programs in order to access, evaluate and present information using computer technologies. Basic concepts of information technologies, software and hardware, operating systems in general, word processing programs, spreadsheet programs, data presentation, use of the Internet in education, the effects of information technologies on social structure and their place in education, information systems security and ethical concepts

Helitam 15 Biostatistics: Theoretical total (28 weeks) - 112 hours

Introduction and Basic Concepts, Descriptive Statistics (Figures, Graphs, Location Measures, Distribution Measures, Evaluation), Possibilities, Population Distributions, Sampling and Sample Size, Estimates, Hypothesis Testing, Regression and Correlation, Analysis of Variance, Health Specific Statistics.

Helitam 21 Management and organization: Theoretical total(28 weeks) -168 hours

Basic Concepts and Theories of Management, Development of Management Science and Management Theories, National Health System and Health Policies, Management Process, Management Process Planning, Management Process Organizing, Management Process Directing/Executing, Management Process Coordination, Management Process Control.

Helitam 22 Health Legislation and Nursing: Theoretical total (28 weeks) - 168 hours

Nursing Legislation and Health Policy, National Health System and Related Legislation, Nursing Profession and Its Place in the Administrative Organization, Nurses' Rights, Nurses' Responsibilities, People's Health Education and Nursing, Patient Rights and Nursing, Discipline and Registry Affairs in the Nursing Profession, Regulation on Disciplinary Supervisory.

Helitam 23 Nursing Care Management: Theoretical total (28 weeks) - 336 hours

Nursing Classification Systems, Biological and Psychological Concepts in Health Care, Physiopathological Concepts in Health Care, Surgical Care (Pre-operative, Operative Period and Postoperative Care), Nursing Care Management in Respiratory System Diseases, Nursing Care Management in Cardio-Vascular System

Diseases, Nursing Care Management in Blood Diseases, Nursing Care Management in Urogenital System Diseases, Nursing Care Management in Breast Diseases, Digestive System Nursing Care Method in Diseases, Nursing Care Management in Metabolism and Endocrine System Diseases, Nursing Care Management in Immune System Diseases, Nursing Care Management in Nervous System Diseases, Nursing Care Management in Musculoskeletal System Diseases, Care Management in Transplantation Nursing, Nursing Care Management of Patient with Eye and Vision Problems, Nursing Care Management of Patient with Hearing and Balance Problems.

Anthropology-Definition-Scope-Branches, Research Methods in Anthropology, Anthropology and Globalization, Knowing the Society, Population Structure and Characteristics (Religion, Language, Race, Ethnic Structure), Migration, What is Culture, What Are Its Features, Concepts Related to Culture (Culture, Society, Individual), Culture-Health-Disease Relationship, Health Care Systems, Cultural Factors Affecting Health Care, Health-Disease Perception and Applications According to Different Cultures, Transcultural Nursing Cultural Care Rules, Culture and Communication, Mass Media, Social and Individual Effects, Social Identity, Personality, Gender, Social Class, Stratification and Inequality, Types of Education, Culture and Education Relationship

Helitam 25 Interpersonal Relations and Communication in Nursing: Theoretical total (28 weeks) - 168 hours

Nurse-Patient Relationship and Communication, Effective Communication, Communication Techniques, Non-Therapeutic Communication Techniques, The Importance of Self-Awareness in Communication, Concepts Affecting Interpersonal Relationships, Communication in Special Situations, Communication with Group, Working Life and Communication, Empathy and Understanding the Patient's Behavior, Assertiveness, Counseling.

Helitam 26 Internship Application-240 hours

The application of the "Internship Practice" course is carried out under the coordination of the Provincial Health Directorate, under the control of the "Provincial Practice Coordinator", "Institution Practice Officer" and "Educators" within the framework of the "Clinical Practice Evaluation Form". The applications must be carried out in one of the Gynecology and Obstetrics, Pediatrics, Internal Medicine, Surgery and Psychiatry clinics of the Faculty of Medicine hospitals (University Hospitals), Education and Research Hospitals affiliated to the Ministry of Health; A, B and C group state hospitals. The Institution Official decides which of these clinics the student will attend together with the student. The form must be used for whichever clinic the student will attend.
