Learning Guide

Putting on the Sterile Gloves and Taking off the Contaminated Gloves

Aim: At the end of this training session, participants should overpass the steps easily by performing the steps of the skill correctly and timely

Tools: Liquid soap, paper towel, sterile gloves

STEPS

Putting on the gloves

- 1. Wash your hands
- 2. Control the expiration date, and check whether the glove cover is damaged or not
- 3. Open the glove cover without tearing the second paper cover in it
- 4. Turn the wrist side of the glove cover towards you
- 5. Hold your active hand's glove with your other hand from the folded wrist part
- 6. Slide the fingers of your active hand into the glove
- 7. Place your hand by pulling the folded part
- 8. Hold your other hand's glove by placing your active hand's first four fingers inside the folded wrist part
- 9. Slide fingers of your other hand into the glove
- 10. Clasp your hands so that the gloves are worn properly

Taking off the contaminated gloves

- 11. Hold tightly the inner side of the glove with the first two fingers of your hand
- 12. Pull out the glove by reversing the inside
- 13. Put the glove in the palm of gloved hand without touching the outside of the glove with the naked hand
- 14. Hold tightly the inside of the glove wrist with the second and third fingers of the naked hand
- 15. Pull out the glove by reversing the inside and holding the other glove in it
- 16. Discard the gloves in the basket with red liner (for medical waste)
- 17. Discard the glove cover in the basket with black liner (for general waste)
- 18. Wash your hands
